# **Medical/Health Requirements**

All students must meet Illinois Physical Examination and Immunization requirements by the first day of school. Students not in compliance have until September 15, 2025.

If you have religious objections, you must submit the **Certificate of Religious Exemption**, signed by a physician.

### Required Exams & Vaccines by Grade

#### **Preschool & Pre-K**

- ✓ Lead blood test
- ✓ Immunizations:
  - DPT/DTaP: 4 doses
  - IPV/OPV (polio): 3 doses
  - Varicella (chickenpox): 1 dose or proof of immunity
  - MMR: 1 dose
  - Hepatitis B: 3 doses
  - Hib: 1 dose after 15 months
  - Pneumococcal: 1 dose (if no primary series)

## **Dental Exam**

Required for students in **kindergarten**, **2nd**, **and 6th grades**, completed by a licensed dentist **between Nov 2024–April 15**, **2025**.

### **Vision Exam**

Required for students entering Kindergarten or enrolling in an Illinois school for the first time. Must be done by a licensed optometrist or physician within one year before October 15, 2025.

#### Physical Exam & Sports

- A current physical exam with immunizations is required for all new students, including those transferring from out of state.
- Students transferring from another Illinois school must provide their most recent physical, dental, and eye exam records within **30 days of starting**.
- Students playing middle or high school sports must have a physical dated within 1 year
  of the end of the sports season. (IHSA forms do not meet school requirements.)

### **Medications at School**

Over-the-counter and prescription medications require a **Medication Authorization Form**, signed by a parent/guardian and healthcare provider. Special forms are available for asthma, diabetes, seizures, and allergies.

### **Hearing & Vision Screenings**

State-required screenings are done at school. Vision screening does not replace a full eye exam. Parents will be notified if their child does not pass.

## Parent Resource - Quick Guide

School starts at 8:15 AM. School ends at 3:30 PM Monday–Thursday and at 2:00 PM on Friday. Drop-off begins at 7:30 AM.

#### **Attendance**

- Call the office within 24 hours to report absences. Provide:
  - Student's name
  - Reason for absence
- Valid reasons: illness, religious holiday, family emergency, immediate family death, safety concern.
- For vacations: submit a **pre-arranged absence form** (not recommended).
- For appointments during school:
  - Call ahead, student signs out/in at office, and bring doctor's note.
- Unexcused absences (e.g., oversleeping, car trouble) = no make-up work.

### **Health**

If ill at school, student goes to office. Parents will be called if needed.

## **Visiting School**

- All visitors must check in at the office.
- Deliveries (lunches, items) must go through the office.

### **Cell Phone Policy**

All you need is an Internet-capable computer.

Here's how to access our easy-to-use FACTS Family Portal:

- Type your school's **District Code HA-IL**.
- Then type in your username and password that you created during registration.
- If you have forgotten your password, then **Click the change password** link. This link is only valid for 30 minutes.

- Type a **User Name**, **Password** and **Confirm** the password.
- Click Save Password.
- A message displays at the top of the browser, "User Name/Password successfully updated."
- You can now log into Family Portal using your new User Name and Password.
