## HEALTH CORNER

- **The COVID Vaccine is NOW AVAILABLE for everyone 5 years of age and over, when your child is vaccinated, please provide a copy of their vaccination card to the front office.**
- Thank you for keeping our community safe! **If you travel internationally over the holidays please check the CDC guidance for testing and quarantine restrictions when you return. COVID-19 Traveler Information (state.gov)**
- Keep your students home when they exhibit symptoms associated with COVID, such as headache, fever, cough, stomach ache, runny nose, etc.
- It is imperative you report when a household member has tested positive for COVID-19 or is displaying symptoms.
- According to the IL Department of Health "Schools shall exclude any Student or School Personnel who exhibit symptoms of COVID-19, as defined by the CDC, until they test negative for COVID-19 or for a minimum of 10 days, until they are fever free for 24 hours and until 48 hours after diarrhea or vomiting have ceased."
- **In order to return to school after you have experience ANY Covid symptoms you must provide a negative PCR test.**



# HAA STEM CLUB

This year, under the guidance of Mrs. Navarro, HAA has started multiple STEM/STEAM Clubs, this incorporates Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, and Math into all their activities.

In the past, we have had two middle school LEGO Robotics teams who have competed on the national level. This year, for the first time ever, we have a HS Robotics team, 2 MS LEGO Robotics teams, and an Elementary STEAM Club of 24 students, K-4, led by Mrs. Triana Ward.

HAA is currently developing an area for a Makerspace Lab for innovators, inventors, and curious kids. A makerspace is a place for hands-on learning with many of the tools needed for creativity, innovation, collaboration, and invention. This lab will be a room for students to explore, take apart, put together, try it again, construct knowledge, process patterns, deconstruct, and persist, building resilience and problem solving.

This room will have computers, creation space, robotics tables, cubbies for storage, idea guides, and invention challenges. We already have a 3D printer, a Green Screen, a coming 1Kw Photovoltaic solar panel (from the IL Clean Energy Foundation Grant), and lots of ideas to put into action.



HAA's STEM leader, Mrs. Navarro says, "I'm excited that HAA has a vision of bringing STEM to our school as it fosters critical thinking and innovation."

"In the Spring, we plan to partner up with Andrews University and host a STEM MISSION...INVENT! event where students will have the opportunity to demonstrate their abilities to invent a prototype that can help offer solutions to real-world problems."

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


We have been in the Hinsdale neighborhood for over 100 years, but this is only the beginning of our community work!




