All International students must submit an application form for acceptance. Once a student is accepted into Hinsdale Adventist Academy, an I-20 and acceptance letter will be issued to the student. It is then their responsibility to secure their visa. Acceptance into Hinsdale Adventist Academy does not guarantee students will receive a visa.

International Students

Students who require an I-20 to attend school will be charged a non-refundable \$250 application fee. All I-20 students are required to pay the yearly tuition in advance in order to enroll. Tuition is charged per school year and is non-refundable. Family discounts are not applicable. All other fees apply as per schedule. I-20 students are also required to show proof of medical coverage in the United States prior to enrollment.

Tuition Rates

Tuition is used to cover part of the cost of operating Hinsdale Adventist Academy. Members of the Seventh-day Adventist church support Adventist education with substantial church and conference subsidies.

Registration Fee

The registration fee covers items such as student accident insurance, standardized testing, technology, textbooks and yearbook. The registration fee is non-refundable.
