Registration

Students are not fully registered until the registration fee has been paid in full and all enrollment documents have been submitted to the office.

Family Discount

A 5% discount will be given to the second child in the family, 10% for the third, 15% for the fourth, and 20% for any additional children. The family discount is reflected in the tuition schedule.

Tuition Assistance

Tuition assistance may be available to qualifying students through the following sources:

<u>Church Tuition Assistance:</u> Some churches provide tuition assistance to eligible members. Please contact your church pastor or treasurer for further information.

<u>School Financial Aid:</u> Hinsdale Adventist Academy has limited resources available for qualifying families based on need. Applications are available in FACTS.

<u>Assist/PFE Work Program:</u> Hinsdale Adventist Academy, in partnership with Southern Adventist University's ASSIST grant program, has the opportunity to offer unique tuition assistance to our students. Through this service-oriented program, our participating students are paired with elderly adults in our community in a mutually-beneficial way. Not only are these students developing skills needed to be successful—commitment, leadership, communication and interpersonal skills, empathy,

and collaboration—they are also learning the value of service.

International Students

Students who require an I-20 to attend school will be charged a non-refundable \$250 application fee. All I-20 students are required to pay the yearly tuition in advance in order to enroll. Tuition is charged per school year and is non-refundable, please see the international student financial brochure for tuition rates. Family discounts are not applicable. All other fees apply as per schedule. I-20 students are also required to show proof of medical coverage in the United States prior to enrollment. Call the registrar for details.

Upfront Payment Discount

A 5% discount will be given to families who pay the entire tuition amount on or before the first day of school.

Referral Incentive

Any HAA family who refers a <u>new family</u> to Hinsdale Adventist Academy, who subsequently enrolls their child for the year, will receive a onetime \$200 credit toward their tuition.

Tuition Billing Procedures

Tuition is divided into ten (10) installments and billed <u>August through May.</u> A monthly statement will be emailed and or mailed to the responsible party from FACTS. Parents may access their tuition and fees account through FACTS at any time and set up auto pay. Tuition is due the 5th or 20th of the month depending on the date selected with FACTS.

Registration Fees

The registration fee covers student accident insurance, technology, FACTS, yearbook, Home & School dues, school supplies (pre-K - 5), elementary field trips, school textbooks (K-8), class dues and electives (6-12), one ACT test(11-12), student association dues, and music dues. HAA requires that \$100 per child is received during the open enrollment month to hold your student's seat.

The registration fee is non-refundable. Registration is due in full by the first day of school. Enrollment will open the spring prior to the upcoming school year. At that time, you will be able to make payments towards your registration payments. We understand for some families coming up with registration payments in full is a challenge. Please talk with the business manager to create a plan that will work for your family as well as the school.

Delinquent Accounts

Parents who enroll students in HAA have entered into a contractual agreement with the school and are expected to live up to these commitments. Monthly balances or approved financial agreements must be kept current.

If the family's account is not current, the student will not be allowed to take final exams. It is not the intent of the Administration to exclude children from school, but to emphasize to parents the need for them to contact the school office to make other arrangements when they cannot make their tuition payments on time.

In addition, it is Hinsdale Adventist Academy's policy that no student shall receive a diploma/transcript/report card, if any financial obligations are outstanding. For accounts with a 90 day delinquency, HAA does reserve the right to withdraw the student.
